Clients also certify that, as of today, the household lives in the area served by this agency. This information is provided in connection with the receipt of Federal assistance through The Emergency Food Assistance Program and/or the state funded food program.

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Food Programs guidelines were obtained by multiplying the 2012 Federal income poverty guidelines by 2, and subtracting \$1.00 and by rounding down to the next whole dollar. Weekly and monthly guidelines were computed by dividing annual income by 52 and 12, respectively, and by rounding down to the next whole dollar.
